2. Processing of your data when contacting us

If you provide us with personal data when contacting us, p.ex. by e-mail or via our contact form we collect and process your data according to Art. 6 (1) sent. 1 point (b) GDPR for the performance of a contract with you or in order to take steps at your request prior to entering into a contract or according to Art. 6 (1) sent. 1 point (f) GDPR for the purpose of our legitimate interest to answer your request. If you provide us with your data via our contact form, we will also store your IP address after you have submitted your data via the contact form, in order to be able to prove that we have received your data on the basis of your entry in our contact form. Our legitimate interest to store the IP address is to be able to defend ourselves against the assertion of claims. We do not use your data beyond these purposes.

3. Logfiles

When you access this website, the browser deployed on your terminal device will automatically send information to our website server. This information is temporarily saved in a so-called log file. In this process, the following information will be collected without any action on your part and stored until its automated deletion, usually after one week:

- IP address of the computer sending the request,
- Date and time of website Access,

- Name and URL of the retrieved file,
- Website from which this website was accessed (referral URL),
- Browser used and, if applicable, your computer's operating system as well as the name of your access provider.

The above-listed data will be processed by us for the following purposes:

- Ensuring a smooth connection setup to the website,
- Ensuring easy use of our Website,
- Evaluation of system security and stability,
- Clarification of any improper page access (DoS/DDoS attacks, etc.).#

The legal basis for the processing of personal data is Art. 6 (1) sent. 1 point (f) GDPR. Our legitimate interest is derived from the above-listed purposes for data collection. We generally do not use collected data for the purpose of drawing conclusions about your person. However, we reserve the right to do so if required to investigate improper page access. In individual cases, we therefore also store the data for an extended period, e.g. in order to be able to enforce claims due to misuse of our website.

4. Encryption

Data you insert on our website is transferred in encrypted form (SSL). We take technical and organizational measures to secure our website and other systems against loss, destruction, access, modification or dissemination of your data by unauthorized persons.

5. Categories of recipients of the personal data; data transfer to a third country

Service providers and auxiliary agents used by us in connection with the website, p.ex. the provider of this website AEGsonnepanelen.nl, host provider, agencies and IT service providers may have access to your personal data. However, insofar these service providers and auxiliary agents process data on our behalf they only act according to our instructions and we concluded adequate contracts with them. This applies accordingly to service providers which have their legal seat in a third country (outside the EU/EEA).

6. RIGHTS OF DATA SUBJECTS

You have the following rights:

- If we process personal data on the basis of your consent, to withdraw your consent at any time in accordance with Art. 7 para. 3 GDPR; as a result, we may no longer continue to process the data based on this consent in the future; the withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal;
- To obtain information from us about the personal data we process according to Art. 15 GDPR. In particular, you may request information about the purposes of the processing, the categories of personal data, the categories of recipients to whom your personal data have been or will be disclosed, the envisaged period for which the personal data will be stored, the existence of the right to request rectification, erasure, restriction of processing or to object, the right to lodge a complaint, the source of your data if they were not collected by us, as well as the existence of automated decision-making, including profiling, as well as meaningful information about the associated details;
- To request without undue delay the rectification of incorrect or incomplete personal data stored by us according to Art. 16 GDPR;

- To request, according to Art. 17 GDPR, the erasure of personal data stored with us, unless the processing is necessary for exercising the right of freedom of expression and information, full compliance with legal obligations, for reasons of public interest, or for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal Claims;
- To request restriction of processing your personal data according to Art. 18 GDPR, if you contest the accuracy of the data, if the processing is unlawful but you oppose the erasure of the data, and if we no longer need the personal data but you require them for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims, or if you exercised your right to object to processing according to Art. 21 GDPR;
- To request your personal data, which you have provided to us, in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format or to demand the transmission to another controller according to Art. 20 GDPR; and
- To the extent your personal data is processed on the basis of legitimate interests pursuant to Art. 6 subsection 1, sentence 1, lit. f, GDPR, you have the right to object to the processing of your personal data pursuant to Art. 21 GDPR on grounds relating to your particular situation.
- To the extent your personal data is processed for direct marketing purposes, you have the right to object at any time to the processing of your data for such marketing, including profiling, insofar as it is related to such direct marketing, in accordance with Art. 21 subsection 2 GDPR;
- To lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority in accordance with Art. 77 GDPR. You can generally contact the supervisory authority at your usual place of residence or workplace or at our seat for this purpose.

7. Period of data storage and routine deletion

Insofar nothing else is explicitly stated above we process and store personal data only for the period, which is required to meet the purpose of processing, or as long and to the extent as statutory laws require us to process and/or store such data.

If the purpose of processing does not apply anymore or the applicable statutory retention requirement expires, we will as a matter of routine erase data or restrict the processing of data in accordance with the applicable statutory laws.
